**SPECIMEN**

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*The case study below is intended to give an indication of the type of question that will be set. As the paper will involve additional material being added to each question, the information below may not be enough to answer the sample questions completely.*

Over time further developments were added to Knitsley Mill. These included the creation of a car park and the house was converted into a restaurant and bar. Staff were recruited to work in the restaurant and the number of employees was increased when the restaurant was extended. Local businesses were used to supply fresh food for the restaurant. They also worked with a local shop in Consett to sell fishing tackle and a golf driving range was added. As the restaurant and bars were frequented by many of the people living in Knitsley, the management were able to discuss their development plans with them informally.

In 2002 the management planned to extend the mill further. Planning permission was submitted to Derwentside Council for the following:

- To erect a ski-slope purchased from a leisure centre in the North East
- To build a nine hole golf course
- To convert one of the original, and currently derelict, buildings to provide visitor accommodation
