This assignment enables you to demonstrate that you can:

Task	Assessment evidence – a learner must
1	Evidence of understanding of the necessity for health and safety rules – e.g. general safety of people, protection from hazards, dirt, spillage, personal comfort, fire and accident.
2	Evidence of understanding (written or oral) of the legal responsibilities of employer and employee as set out in the Health & Safety At Work Act (1974). Learner may list or display (e.g. poster) three or four main points.
3	Evidence of awareness of appropriate behaviour in a workplace or community set-up. A list, with details, of at least four items.
4	Provide details of a risk assessment of common hazards encountered in a workplace, simulation or community environment.
5	Produce own record of three occasions when he/she applied common health and safety rules to activities being undertaken.

The above evidence will enable the learner to demonstrate that they can:

- Recognise why following health and safety rules is important, either in a workplace, or in the community
- Understand their rights and responsibilities in a workplace, or their rights and responsibilities in the community
- Understand why they should work safely
- Recognise hazards in a workplace, or in the community
