Task	Assessment evidence – a learner must
1	Show evidence of understanding of and ability to reference to the main points of the HASAWA (1974). Learners' work might be in the form of a descriptive list or poster, brochure, leaflet etc.
2	Demonstrate perception of danger areas. Learner to produce comprehensive list of hazards and responses to each.
3	Show evidence of understanding of employee rights and responsibilities in the workplace <i>or</i> the community with some appropriate links to their own experiences.
4	Submit a log or diary recording appropriate behaviour with regard to special instructions, use of protective clothing, specialist equipment, safe working practices etc.
5	Produce a comparison of evidence showing an understanding of the principles of risk assessment for at least three different environments. Presentation materials and record of reporting (tutor or peer group evidence).

The above evidence will enable the learner to demonstrate that they can:

- Understand health and safety needs at work, or in the community
- Evaluate their rights and responsibilities in a workplace, or in the community
- Recognise the importance of safe working
- Investigate and present information about health and safety hazards
